*"Sing-Out has a very big meaning behind it. It means just what it says — Up With People. It's made people aware you have to respect and consider everyone around you."*

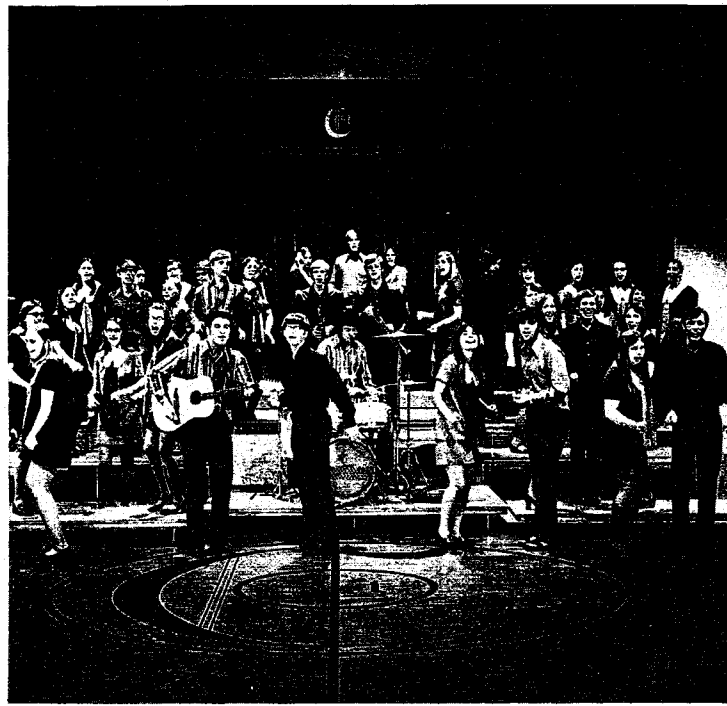
